◆ **Part Two** - A pair of feet, human, pet...etc made out of USED bio degradable materials, like paper, cardboard (paper mache), fabric, string, wood, plant materials like grasses, reeds, yarns, threads...and so on. This 3D piece to be part of a group installation.
